

2024 Summer Intern Program - Business Majors Accounting, Finance, Information Technology, Business Administration, or Supply Chain Majors

Air Liquide develops innovative technologies and sustainable solutions, optimizing the use of air and the planet's natural resources, enabling progress and preserving life. Located in over 80 countries, we have more than 1,000,000 customers globally in diverse industries such as steel, food and beverage, electronics and pharmaceuticals. By using gasses naturally present in the atmosphere, Air Liquide separates and purifies them into oxygen, nitrogen, argon, and various rare gasses and then distributes them to clientele by pipeline, compression, cylinders, or in some cases, produced directly on a clients' site. Air Liquide also uses other natural resources of gas to produce other gasses caused by chemical reactions for their clients' usage (hydrogen, carbon dioxide, acetylene, helium, ozone, carbon monoxide).

Below are the types of internships available:

- **Our IT division** is responsible for supporting system applications for the US, Canada, Mexico, Trinidad and Colombia. Air Liquide utilizes Oracle and works with the business to determine what enhancements/new features they would like to deploy. Students will be exposed to writing design documents, working with the development team, test changes and work with end users.
- **Network Intern (virtual or Houston, TX):** The Network team is in charge of providing Internet and Telephony for all Air Liquide locations in the Americas. Intern will support network Service Delivery Managers (SDM) with current projects to learn the SDM process. Intern will act as SDM to complete one or more Demand engagements from beginning to end starting with assessment of customer need, requesting quotes for hardware and service, preparing and presenting a proposal, approval and implementation of the solution.
- Supply Chain Management Assist the Category Specialist team during the execution of sourcing events.
 Provide support for market studies and cost-modeling for potential new categories to be sourced. Compile
 various Training/Process Flow documents into two electronic formats (Buyer & Customer focus). Create
 dashboards for Payment Term Requests/Approvals for Purchasing Services. Identify cost driver components for
 a new commodity and build a forecasting model. Support the Supply Chain Quality Audit team in auditing local
 suppliers. Assist with the modification of inventory management material descriptions for a defined population
 of critical spares.

General Requirements:

- Pursuing a bachelor's degree in Information Technology, Accounting, Finance Business Administration, or Supply Chain Majors
- Expected graduation between August 2025 and May 2027
- Minimum cumulative overall GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Must be able to relocate to internship location in the US
- Must be able to provide own daily transportation to/from work
- Must secure and finance own housing
